

User Agreement

Terms of Use

This web site with its home page in the domain "conect.org" (the "Website") is a complimentary information and interactive community service offered by the Coalition of New England Companies for Trade ("CONECT") at no charge to users of the World Wide Web, with the express condition that these users agree to be bound by the terms and conditions set forth in this User Agreement. CONECT reserves the right to change these terms and conditions at any time, without notice to you, and you must consult the most recent version of this User Agreement (not an older cached version) each time you view the Website. Use of this Website constitutes your acceptance of all of the following terms and conditions, in their current form or as modified.

Description of Service

CONECT assumes no responsibility or liability for the timeliness, deletion, mis-delivery or failure to store any user communications or personalization data or settings. All such risks shall be borne by you.

Registered User Account, Password, and Security

Users may register and create a personal account profile to provide more personalized information. Users are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of the user ID and password, and are fully responsible for all activities that occur under their account. CONECT does not retain liability or responsibility for such use.

General Practices Regarding Use and Storage

Users acknowledge that CONECT may establish general practices and limits concerning use of the CONECT web site, including without limitation the maximum number of days that email messages, message board postings or other uploaded content is retained by the web site.
