FY2011 Highlights

The Loudoun Free Clinic continues to provide first rate medical services during financially challenging times. Thanks to your support, we have expanded and improved the delivery of privately funded health care to the less fortunate in our county. Your compassion and generosity have provided tangible help and hope to those in need.

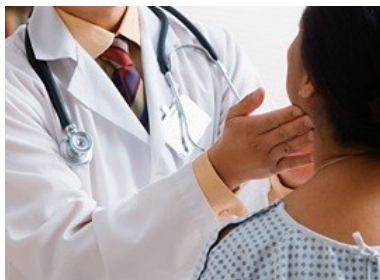
Looking back over the past year, the dynamic growth of our charitable services is reflected in the facts below.

- ♥ During FY11, the LFC served 1,540 patients with 2,904 visits— a 57% increase in patients over Fy10.
- ♥ Our volunteers donated over 5,000 hours to the Free Clinic during FY11.
- ♥ In 2010 the Free Clinic hired a Physician Assistant, allowing us to schedule daytime clinics 4 days a week.
- ♥ Over 60 medical professionals donated their time to see patients at the clinic, and 45 local specialty care providers accepted referrals from the Clinic to see our patients in their own facilities at no charge.
- ♥ The Clinic offered patient appointments 35 hours each week, and averaged 60 visits per week for FY11.
- ♥ In Fy11 the Free Clinic delivered \$7.04 in health care services for every dollar spent.
- ♥ Through our work with the Patient Assistance Program and partnership with NovaScripts Central, we dispensed a total of 13,859 prescriptions to our patients. This is an increase of 265% over FY10 and is valued at almost \$2,000,000.00.

In FY11 Loudoun Free Clinic increased the number of patients served by 57%

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STORIES OF HOPE

Luisa

A year and a half ago Luisa started to have painful headaches and severe nasal drainage. She went to two doctors and was even hospitalized. Her ongoing condition was attributed to allergies. Luisa struggled with depression and anxiety because no medication seemed to make a difference. She had no health insurance and she was barely able to pay for rent and food, let alone medical care. Luisa's co-worker suggested she go to the Loudoun Free Clinic.

When Luisa first came to the Clinic she met with Bernadette, our Patient Services Coordinator. Bernadette was alarmed by the fluid leaking from Luisa's nose and insisted she have an immediate appointment. The Clinic sent her for labs and X-rays, and arranged for an emergency consult with one of our providers. It was here that surgeons found a skull fracture that left Luisa vulnerable to a wide range of dangerous and life threatening infections.

In addition to the life-saving treatment Luisa received through the Free Clinic, she is being treated for diabetes and hypertension. Like so many of our patients, Luisa had complex and extensive medical needs that went undiagnosed and untreated for years. By the time she came to us she was dangerously ill with a life threatening condition.

LFC was able to provide all of Luisa's treatment and medications through the generosity of volunteers, our medical referral network and our in-kind and financial donors. Bernadette, the staff member Luisa met with initially, has personally delivered medications to Luisa's home when she was unable to come to the Clinic. Luisa's life and health are dramatically improved because there is a Free Clinic in our county.



George

George Wilson worked for years as a custodian at a local school until last year when a stroke left him paralyzed on his right side. Unable to work, he went on disability. He struggled to make ends meet and eventually moved in with his mother. They are a close family and depend on one another in every way. Sharing her home was Mrs. Wilson's way of helping her son. Weeks later, George's mother suffered a stroke.

With both George and his mother stroke victims, life was hard. He came to the Clinic under dire circumstances unable to pay for food, housing, and desperately needed medical care. The Clinic immediately scheduled him for intensive physical therapy. He was also scheduled for consult appointments for cardiology and neurology. There was a wait list, but the day of the appointment finally came. Tragically his brother, who would drive him the 2 1/2 hours to his appointment, died that morning of a stroke.

George ultimately received every consult. He receives outpatient physical therapy and is connected with social services to ensure he doesn't go hungry. The love and support of countless volunteers and staff have provided help and encouragement for George to keep improving. Despite severe personal loss he is hopeful about the future.

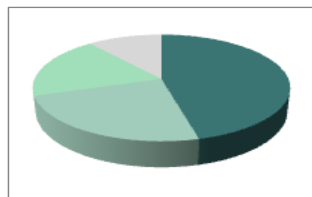
